Busy shift throughout the night. During this shift, several officers were working a special detail at Monte Vista Crossings shopping center for retail theft. Shift began with low volume calls for service. Officers made proactive stops resulting in a few arrests. Around midnight, an infant death investigation was dispatched. Initially, 4 officers were required to handle this call with the investigation eventually being taken over by Detectives. Ultimately no obvious signs or indications of foul play or abuse were identified, pending the coroner's investigation and completion of follow up by TPD Detectives. The infant's mother noticed decreased breathing ability and self-transported them to the hospital. However, the infant unfortunately passed away while en route.
